2021 Aviation Camp will be held most Thursdays, beginning June 17th through August 5th. The last day of Camp will be Tuesday, August 10th.

An exciting addition to Aviation Camp this year is our new FAA-Certified Flight Simulator purchased by Howmet. It will give students the opportunity to receive hands-on instruction from pilots to gain real-world experience in flight. Each student will have time on the simulator every day of camp (unless it is a field trip day).

In addition, we're offering a second, optional Field Trip to EAA AirVenture 2021 in Oshkosh, WI. We will require an adult chaperone for every student. Full details on reverse.

*** The flight is a WEATHER DEPENDENT activity. Every attempt will be made to accommodate each student on a flight. However, no guarantees can be made and if camp passes without the ability to provide students a flight, no rain-check dates will be scheduled.

OPTIONAL EAA AirVenture Field Trip Details:

Cost for student enrolled in camp: \$10

Cost for chaperone: \$85

Cost for additional sibling (18 or under) NOT enrolled in camp: \$50

These costs are in addition to the cost of Aviation Camp and cover bus and entrance fees.

*First priority will be given to camp students. If there is room on a bus, additional seats will be made available to family members in the order in which registration forms are received.

Each student attending this optional field trip is **REQUIRED** to have an adult chaperone. Additional family members are welcome to join as well if space is available. This field trip is first come, first serve. We have two 55 passenger charter buses that will drive participants from La Porte Municipal Airport to OshKosh, Wisconsin. The buses will leave La Porte Municipal Airport promptly at 5:00 am.

Your entrance ticket is included in the price of the field trip. Once we arrive at EAA AirVenture, you are free to explore as you wish. Things to do can be found on the AirVenture’s website, <https://www.eaa.org/airventure/ea-airventure-schedule-of-events>, and we encourage you to make a plan for the day as there is much to see.

The buses will leave AirVenture promptly at 6:30pm. Be sure to bring a phone with you to receive reminder texts and updates. We plan to arrive back to La Porte around 11 pm.

Please complete the registration form in its entirety. Registration is limited and is on a first-come, first-served basis. Camp fills early so prompt return of form and payment is advised. If you are registering multiple students, fill out a separate form for each student. **Bring or mail this form and a check to the LaPorte Municipal Airport between the hours of 9 am – 5 pm by Friday, May 14, 2021. No registrations will be accepted after May 14.**
